Eligibility

- Scientists at LMIC institutions may partner with scientists in the United States and/or at other low and middle-income country institutions. (Income categories are defined by [The World Bank Country and Lending Groups](#) .
- Applicants are encouraged to consult with participating NIH Institutes or Offices (see list of partners below) while developing their applications.
- The proposed research must be relevant to the interests stated in the funding opportunity announcement of one of the participating NIH Institutes, Centers or Offices listed in the FOAs. The ***R01 Applications*** must be relevant to the mission of one of the participating ICs *other than FIC* as listed in the FOA.
- **Applicants who need time and funding to develop research collaborations and capacity, and to conduct pilot studies, are encouraged to apply first to the R21.**
