In connection with the introduction of the credit-transfer-accumulation system, the assessment of knowledge and skills of fourth-year students of the medical faculty is carried out according to the following criteria:

A. – Assimilation of each topic of practical classes is assessed according to the *traditional system* with grades: «5», «4», «3», «2».

– The calculation of the number of points is based on the grades obtained by the student during the study of the discipline during the semester on a traditional scale, by calculating the arithmetic mean (AM), rounded to two decimal places; the value obtained is converted into points on a multi-point scale as follows: $x = (MA \times 200) / 5$.

B. – Maximum number of points for the current educational activity of the student: 200 points.

- The minimum number of points that a student must score for the current academic activity to enroll in the discipline is 120 points.

C. – Assessment of independent work: Assessment of independent work of students, which is provided in the topic along with the classroom work, is carried out during the current control of the topic in the relevant classroom.

Assessment of topics that are submitted only for independent work and are not included in the topics of classroom classes, are controlled in the final lesson.

Final control: Final control is carried out upon completion of the study of all topics in the discipline.

For the discipline "Neurology" the form of final control is an exam:

A student is admitted to the exam if he has fulfilled the requirements of the curriculum and if for the current academic activity he received positive marks and scored a minimum number of points - 72 points.
