

## Criteria for evaluating

Excellent ("5") - the student correctly, clearly, logically and fully answers all standardized questions of the current topic, including questions of the lecture course and independent work. Closely connects theory with practice and correctly demonstrates the implementation (knowledge) of practical skills. freely reads the results of analyzes, solves situational problems of increased complexity, is able to summarize the material, has the methods of examining the patient in the amount necessary for the activities of the doctor. Completed the planned individual work.

Good ("4") - the student correctly and essentially answers standardized questions of the current topic, including questions of the lecture course and independent work. Demonstrates the implementation (knowledge) of practical skills. Correctly uses theoretical knowledge in solving practical problems.

Satisfactory ("3") - the student incompletely, with the help of additional questions, answers standardized questions of the current topic, lecture course and independent work. Cannot independently build a clear, logical answer.

Unsatisfactory ("2") - the student does not know the material of the current topic, cannot build a logical answer, does not answer additional questions, does not understand the content of the material.

Criteria for testing in the MISA system (in accordance with Order No. 3153-z) in connection with the possible transition to distance learning):

- • At least 10 test tasks on the topic of the lesson.
- • 50 – 60% of correct answers – satisfactory ("3");
- • 70 – 80% – good ("4");
- • 90 – 100% excellent ("5").
