**Inflammatory processes in the oral and maxillofacial area**

1. To prepare the set of instruments for dissection the mucosal operculum in the presence of pericoronitis of 38, 48 teeth.
2. To prepare a set of tools for dissection the mucosal operculum in the presence of pericoronitis of 18, 28 teeth.
3. To prepare the set of instruments for operations of resection root apex of the tooth.
4. To prepare the set of instruments for cystectomy.
5. To prepare the set of instruments to for cystotomy.
6. To prepare the set of instruments necessary for tissue incision in the presence of periostitis.
7. To prepare the set of instruments needed to sequestrectomy.
8. To prepare the set of instruments for opening and drainage of the phlegmon of submandibular space.
9. To prepare the set of instruments for opening and drainage of the phlegmon of parotid-masticatory area, pterygoid-mandibular space and temporal area.
10. To prepare the set of instruments required for opening and drainage of abscess of the mandibular-lingual groove.
11. To prepare the set of instruments required for opening and drainage of phlegmon of the infratemporal area, pterygopalatine fossa (with different approaches).
12. To prepare the set of instruments required for opening and drainage of abscesses of the canine fossa.
13. To prepare the set of instruments required for opening and drainage of phlegmon of the orbit.
14. To prepare the set of instruments required for opening and drainage of abscess of the maxillofacial area in the presence of furuncle.
15. To prepare the set of instruments required for opening and drainage of abscess maxillofacial area with carbuncles.
16. To be able to read and set a preliminary diagnosis on radiographs in these diseases:
  - a) Periodontitis;
  - b) Bone osteomyelitis of the facial skeleton, sinusitis;
  - c) Diseases of the salivary glands.
