Oncology of the maxillofacial area

1. To make a plan of the organization of maxillofacial injured care during medical evacuation.
2. To make a plan for the integrated treatment of patients with gunshot injuries.
3. To be able to make a medical history and conduct the examination in patients with benign and malignant tumors of the maxillofacial area.
4. To be able to make a plan of examination of patients with benign and malignant tumors of the maxillofacial area.
5. To be able to work out a diagnosis plan and interpretation of additional methods of examination in patients with MFA soft tissues.
