- 1. Be able to take the history and conduct the clinical inspection of patient, correctly to design case history, set a diagnosis and appoint treatment.
- 2. Be able to conduct any type of the local anaesthetizing in a maxillofacial area.
- 3. To conduct the typical operation of tooth extraction.
- 4. To conduct the atypical tooth extraction operation.
- 5. Independently to conduct dissection at periostitis and periodontal abscess.
- 6. Be able to stop bleeding after tooth extraction.
- 7. To set a diagnosis and treat the patient with alveolitis and alveoloneuritis.
- 8. Be able to treat a sharp alveolar edge.
- 9. To inspect a patient with a haematoma, contracture and conduct the treatment.
- 10. Inspect a patient with pericoronitis, diagnosis and treat the patient (dissection of mucous membrane, removal of it or tooth).
- 11. Inspect a patient with ansinusitis, to set a diagnosis and to appoint the treatment.
- 12. To set a diagnosis and treat the patient with oral antrum.
- 13. Be able to inspect the patient with salivary glands diseases.
- 14. Be able to conduct the bougienage of salivary gland duct.
- 15. Be able to inspect a patient with a phlegmon, to set a diagnosis and to appoint the treatment.
- 16. To inspect a patient with a tumor, to set a diagnosis and to appoint the treatment.
- 17. Be able to conduct aspiration biopsy or to take material for cytological or histological research.
- 18. To inspect a patient with the trauma of maxillofacial area, to set a diagnosis, and to appoint the treatment.
- 19. Be able to conduct the surgical debridement of the wound.
- 20. To conduct temporary immobilization of lower and upper jaws fragments.
- 21. Be able to conduct the correction of tooth splints.
- 22. Be able to conduct a jaw splintage as one of the methods of temporary immobilization.
- 23. To inspect a patient with the dislocation of lower jaw and be able to treat it.
- 24. The first aid for patient with syncope, collapse, shock.
- 25. The first aid for patient with Quincke's edema, anaphylactic shock.
- 26. Be able to conduct artificial respiration and indirect massage of heart.
