

Evaluation criteria of implementation of the typical tasks and skills at practically-oriented exam

In evaluating the results of a comprehensive practically-oriented exam the separate discipline are estimated as a mark, which are within the state certification according to the curriculum and are the part of the Complex.

The results of the practically-oriented exam are estimated as 5 - "excellent", 4 - "good", 3- "satisfactory", 2- "unsatisfactory".

Estimates are set based on points, which are fixed in individual reports of conduction and evaluation of the exam.

Evaluation criteria:

5-4,5 points - "excellent"

4,49 -3,5 points – “good”

3,49-2,51 points – “satisfactory”

2,5 points and less – “unsatisfactory”

Points are defined as follows.

Conduction of the typical tasks and skills which are verified with scores "1", "0,5", "0" (done, not fully done , not done). Points are recorded in the individual reports of conduction and evaluation.

Points for first (second) part of the exam are determined as the average of all points that are fixed in individual reports of conduction and evaluation of the exam of the relevant part of exam.

The resulting point for practically-oriented exam is defined as the average point of the first and second part of the exam, multiplied by a factor of 5.
