Instruction for students (at the stage of Department of Pediatric Dentistry)

Students take examination at Department of Pediatric Dentistry. The number of stages for examination is 3. Each stage is situated in a separate room. The stage number and name are indicated at the entrance.

For the exam, the student comes in medical clothes and medical shoes. At the entrance students must hand over the mobile phones and other gadgets which they will return after completing the examination.

Before the exam, each student is registered in the list with an indication of the exam group. The student receives a serial number, according to which he is registered in the check-list of each stage. Also, the student receives a route list and receives instruction on the order of passing stages.

Students perform the same task at each separate stage.

Students move according to a serial number, thus not being reviewed. The start and end of the stage is sounded with signal. Duration of each stage is the same and is 10 minutes. If during this time the student can not cope with the task, he interrupts his work and goes to the next stage.

There is a 1 minute break between the stages, during which students move from one room to another (from one station to another). After passing the last stage the student gives a route list to the examiner.

The tasks that a student can perform during CPOQE depend on the type of stage, and can be either clinical or practical.

The instructor does not interfere in the process of performing the assignment, does not communicate with the student, but only observes the correctness of his work and puts an assessment of the performance of each stage of the task in check list.

To confirm the objectivity of students' assessment during CPOQE at each stage, it will be performed video recording of the algorithm of a student's clinical or practical task. In case of disagreement of the student with the results of evaluation by the examiner in the check-list of the task, the examination commission in the presence of the student can view the video and make the final decision.
